PhD opportunities for Black British students

Applications are invited from exceptional and ambitious Black British graduates wishing to pursue cutting-edge PhD research at Bayes Business School (formerly Cass).

As part of our work in this area, we hope to help address the significant under-representation of Black British students in postgraduate research and throughout academia.

Studentships will be awarded to students based on outstanding academic achievement and research potential in the following subject areas:

- Accounting
- Actuarial Science
- Finance
- Management, Marketing and Operations Management

THE RESEARCH EXCELLENCE FRAMEWORK (REF) 2021

The REF 2021 rated Bayes 5th in the UK for Business and Management research. In total, 92% of our research was rated as world-leading (4*) or internationally excellent (3*). This highlights the world class quality of Bayes Business School research and recognises the impact it has on business and policymakers.

STUDENTSHIPS

We offer one PhD studentship for Black British students, comprising tuition fees and a maintenance grant of £20,662 per annum for four years, starting in October 2024. The studentship also offers funding for conference attendance over the four years.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The PhD track lasts 4 years with first year students taking taught modules across a range of topics as well as in research methodology. Years 2 to 4 are devoted to working on the PhD dissertation; further training includes reading groups in specific research areas, workshops on presentation skills and academic writing and intense pre-job market training. Together, they form a vibrant and well-integrated intellectual community, where collaborations and exchanges across fields are common.

ELIGIBILITY

Be a UK student, with assessed fee-status equal to 'home'.

Be of Black ethnicity:

- a) Black African
- b) Black Caribbean
- c) Black Other
- d) Mixed – White and Black Caribbean
- e) Mixed – White and Black African
- f) Other mixed background (to include Black African, Black Caribbean or Black Other)

You must hold a first degree (a first or equivalent) in a subject related to your proposed research topic.

The following qualifications are highly desirable and would enhance your likelihood of being accepted:

A master's degree from a leading institution with a distinction or equivalent

A GMAT score (700 or more) if you do not have UK or EU degree.
